LeeCARES completed the After-Action Report for the November exercise and laid out the foundation of the next one to be held in January. We talked to local authorities to have their input as well. We have also worked on a draft for an agreement with Lee County OEM and the Lee County Sheriff's Office and we are waiting for their response. Two members upgraded their license from Technician to General and one almost completed the basic FEMA classes. A couple of us learned and experimented with cross-band repeaters with their radios. A few of us are studying CW and had the first basic conversation on 2 M. We updated and fixed a few problems with Winlink and got radios up to speed. We re-programmed, checked, and strategized to upgrade go-kits and build power boxes. We held a second meeting to plan for the January exercise, and we visited retiring Sheriff, presenting him with a radio and another retirement gift. We went to explore and check the area of the next exercise to decide where to position mobile and base stations. Downloaded and saved in PDF format FEMA flood maps to be used in a rain event or exercise. Drafted first draft of the January exercise involving first time new members in the process and participated in ARES HF nets. Members have kept experimenting with radios, starting a new tower on private residence, and building home-brew antennas.
